I. Situation Overview

On 13 June 2024 at around 10:42 AM, a fire incident occurred at Quirino St., Brgy. 108, Zone 9, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 12:04 PM.

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **23 families** or **77 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 108, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P18,597.80** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
