

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Carol-an, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental

25 April 2025, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 May 2024, at around 5:00 PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Carol-an, City of Kabankalan, Negros Occidental, between the Philippine Army's 94th Infantry Battalion (94IB) and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA). This conflict led to the displacement of families and individuals in the community and affected the nearby Brgy. Ayungon in Negros Oriental.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Regions VI and VII, together with the concerned Local Government Units (LGUs), provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 187 families or 755 persons were affected in two (2) barangays in Regions VI and VII (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 124 families or 506 persons sought temporary shelter in two (2) evacuation centers in Regions VI and VII (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **63 families** or **249 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **187 families** or **755 persons** were displaced in **Regions VI** and **VII** (see Annex F).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P636,185.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P581,825.00** from **DSWD** and **P102,240.00** from the **Local Government Unit** (**LGU**) (see Annex G).
