## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Laconon, T'Boli, South Cotabato**

29 June 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 08 June 2024 at around 2:00 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Seben, Brgy. Laconon, T'boli, South Cotabato between the troops of Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and members unidentified armed groups.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **567 families** or **2,835 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Laconon, T'boli, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **38 families** or **146 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Demamis Integrated School** in **Brgy. Laconon, T'boli, South Cotabato** (see Annex B).

### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱289,690.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱140,712.00** from **DSWD** and **₱148,978.60** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
