

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City

31 August 2024, 6AM

## I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2024 at around 8:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at KM 3, Marcos Highway, Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 10:00 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **five (5) families** or **11 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **two (2) families** or **six (6) persons** sought temporary shelter at a **Multi-purpose Hall** in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1) is totally damaged** and **three (3) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Bakakeng Central, Baguio City** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱108,582.27** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱56,304.80** from **DSWD**, **₱43,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱9,277.47** from other stakeholders (see Annex F).
