

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu

01 February 2025, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 23 May 2024 at around 11:53 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:43 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **97 families** or **396 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **97 families** or **396 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Basak Elementary School** in **Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **73 houses** were damaged; of which, **65** are **totally damaged** and **eight (8)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Basak, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱2,833,924.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱968,924.00 from DSWD and ₱1,865,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
