

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ticad, Bantayan, Cebu 30 January 2025, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 March 2024 at around 6:42 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Ticad, Bantayan, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 9:30 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **seven (7) families** or **25 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Ticad, Bantayan, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **seven (7) families** or **25 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **five (5) houses** were damaged; of which, **three (3)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Ticad, Bantayan, Cebu** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱65,719.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱47,736.00** from **DSWD** and **₱17,983.60** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
