

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incidents in Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay

07 February 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 14 June 2024 at 4:00 AM, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsoon may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Zamboanga Peninsula.

On 14 June 2024 at around 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM, several flooding incidents occurred in several barangays in the municipality of Roseller T. Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **164 families** or **810 persons** were affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **17 families** or **75 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Kalahi Evacuation Center** in **Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **147 families** or **735 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **164 families** or **810 persons** were displaced in **Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Roseller Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱80,334.03** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
