





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Oil Spill Incident in New Washington, Aklan

16 June 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 May 2024, an oil spill along the Lagatik River from Brgy. Polo, Washington, Aklan to nearby barangays was traced to a dismantled ship at Metallica Shipyard. The spill reached riverbanks and private-owned ponds, prompting the Local Government Unit (LGU) of New Washington to issue Executive Order No. 034 series of 2024 on 28 May, suspending fishing activities near the shipyard.

This incident severely affected local families whose livelihoods depend on fishing. Prompt response efforts by the LGU, Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), and Metallica Shipyard contained the spill, through the siphoning operations.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Region VI, in collaboration with Metallica Shipyard, swiftly provided aid to affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **466 families** or **1,950 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **New Washington, Aklan** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱519,590.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱296,590.00 from DSWD and ₱223,000.00 from the Metallica Shipyard (see Annex B).
