





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Clan Feud Incident in Brgy. Lomopog, Midsayap, North Cotabato

as of 14 July 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 30 June 2024 at around 3:21 PM, a clan feud (Rido) involving two (2) warring families transpired in Brgy. Lomopog, Midsayap, North Cotabato. The conflict resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the area.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 150 families or 596 persons are affected in Brgy. Lomopog, Midsayap, North Cotabato (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are 150 families or 596 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Lomopog Elementary School in Midsayap, North Cotabato (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}881,150.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}868,650.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}12,500.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
