



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 11 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2024, heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms caused significant flooding in Sultan Kudarat, Maguindanao del Norte. Said rainfall led to the overflow of Ligasawan Marsh, flooding its tributaries and waterways and affecting several families. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) XII

A total of **4,800 families** or **10,680 persons** are affected in **10 barangays** in **Sultan Kudarat**, **Maguindanao del Norte**.

- ₱87.02 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 330,291 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 269,655 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 60,636 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 56,683 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱278.9 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
