





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident at Maharlika Livelihood Center in Brgy. Bagong Lipunan, Baguio City

as of 18 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 July 2024 at around 1:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Maharlika Livelihood Center, Brgy.Bagong, Lipunan, Baguio City.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Cordillera Administrative Region, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Baguio City, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected individuals.
