I. Situation Overview

On 28 June 2024 at around 6:05 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte.

A total of **eight (8) families** or **28 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **eight (8) families** or **28 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **eight (8) houses** were damaged; of which, **five (5)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Anahawan, Bato, Leyte** (see Annex C).
