

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Banaoang, Malasiqui, Pangasinan as of 25 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 July 2024 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Banaoang, Malasiqui, Pangasinan.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Malasiqui, Pangasinan, promptly provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected family.

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Banaoang, Malasiqui, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

One (1) family or **five (5) persons** are temporarily staying with their (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Banaoang, Malasiqui, Pangasinan** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱21,464.14** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family composed of **₱11,904.14** from **DSWD** and **₱9,560.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
