I. Situation Overview

On 27 June 2024 at around 1:57 PM, a fire incident occurred at Natib Street, J. Salinga, Brgy. Barangka Itaas, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 2:58 PM.

A total of **19 families** or **77 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Barangka Itaas, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

There are **19 families** or **77 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Barangka Itaas, Mandaluyong City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Barangka Itaas, Mandaluyong City (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱82,352.84** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex E).
