

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Central Poblacion, Hilongos, Leyte as of 31 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 July 2024 at around 8:31 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Central Poblacion, Hilongos, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 9.30 AM.

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Central Poblacion, Hilongos, Leyte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Central Poblacion Hall** in **Hilongos, Leyte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Central Poblacion, Hilongos, Leyte** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱9,096.38** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected family (see Annex E).
