





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Don Bernardo A. Neri, Calamba, Misamis Occidental

as of 31 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 22 June 2024 at around 5:41 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 2, Brgy. Don Bernardo A. Neri, Calamba, Misamis Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 5:55 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 11 families or 37 persons are affected in Brgy. Don Bernardo A. Neri, Calamba, Misamis Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are two (2) families or seven (7) persons temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) was totally damaged and one (1) was partially damaged in Brgy. Don Bernardo A. Neri, Calamba, Misamis Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}103,444.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}92,444.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}11,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
