





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu

as of 19 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 July 2024 at around 2:08 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:54 PM.

In response to the incident, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region VII, immediately coordinated with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Mandaue City to address the urgent needs of the affected population and provide significant updates on the situation. Moreover, the DSWD ensures its capacity to respond promptly and facilitate requests for relief augmentation as needed.

A total of **72 families** or **300 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 72 families or 300 persons currently taking temporary shelter in Mayor A.S. Fortuna Memorial Elementary School in Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu (see Annex B).

A total of **72 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Guizo**, **Mandaue City**, **Cebu** (see Annex C).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 218,076 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 154,460 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 63,616 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 61,336 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱342.90 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
