

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga as of 16 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2024 at around 1:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Guinatan, Purok 4, Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **two (2) families** or **four (4) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱47,500.11** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱38,272.64** from **DSWD** and **₱9,227.47** from **other Partners** (see Annex D).
