I. Situation Overview

On 07 July 2024 at around 1:20 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Guinatan, Purok 4, Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of two (2) families or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **two (2) families** or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Magaogao, Pinukpuk, Kalinga (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P47,500.11** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **P38,272.64** from **DSWD** and **P9,227.47** from **other Partners** (see Annex D).
