

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City as of 02 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 June 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:07 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **57 families** or **285 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **25 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Iloilo Baptist Church** in **Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **52 families** or **260 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **57 families** or **285 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **19 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱81,246.90.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
