





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Olympia, Makati City

as of 04 July 2023, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 June 2024 at around 1:37 PM, a fire incident occurred at 444 J.P. Rizal Street, Brgy. Olympia, Makati City. The fire was declared out at around 3:34 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **38 families** or **105 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Olympia**, **Makati City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 38 families or 105 persons currently taking temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. Olympia, Makati City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of ten (10) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Olympia, Makati City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P134,238.04** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
