



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Urbiztondo, Pangasinan

as of 17 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2024 at around 7:00 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Poblacion, Urbiztondo, Pangasinan.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Urbiztondo, Pangasinan, promptly provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or 14 persons are affected in Brgy. Poblacion, Urbiztondo, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **three (3) families** or **14 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Poblacion, Urbiztondo, Pangasinan (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱57,138.34 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱43,138.34 from DSWD and ₱14,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
