

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City as of 27 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 22 June 2024 at around 10:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, Santa Cruz, Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City. The fire was declared out at around 10:30 PM.

#### Outside Evacuation Center

There are **one (1) family** or **eight (8) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱6,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
