





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental

as of 06 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2024 at around 10:17 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 10:50 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 17 families or 58 persons are affected in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 17 families or 58 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Gracia Elementary School in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 17 houses were damaged; of which, 14 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}60,000.00\$ worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex D).
