

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Cavite City

as of 15 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2024 at around 3:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 5 and Brgy. 7 in Cavite City. The fire reached at 4th alarm affecting the neighboring houses.

A total of **781 families** or **2,805 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Cavite City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

There are **781 families** or **2,805 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Cavite City** (see Annex B).

15 July 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD FO CALABARZON has an ongoing assessment and validation on the total number of damaged houses. DSWD FO CALABARZON closely coordinates with the LGU of Cavite City for significant updates and any requests for augmentation. DSWD FO CALABARZON activated its Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to continuously monitor the updates on the response intervention of the affected families and persons. DSWD FO CALABARZON Regional Director Barry R. Chua, M.D. instructed the Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) to monitor the situation of affected families and extend all necessary assistance.
