





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Davao Region

as of 02 July 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 02 July 2024, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms caused by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) that may have brought possible flash floods or landslides due to moderate to at times heavy rains in Palawan and Southern Mindanao.

On the same day, Brgy. Inawayan, Santa Cruz, Davao del Sur and Brgy Kinalangan, Malita, Davao Occidental experienced flooding due to heavy rains brought by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).

A total of 155 families or 731 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Region XI (see Annex A).

There are 13 families or 21 persons currently taking temporary shelter at Calumpang Day Care Center in Brgy. Inawayan, Santa Cruz, Davao del Sur (see Annex B).
