

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Navotas City

as of 04 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 June 2024, the Malabon-Navotas Flood Gate was damaged which since then caused flooding in Tanza Kaliwa, Brgy. Tanza I, Navotas City. Although the flooding subsides minutes or hours after, the properties and livelihoods of the families living in the flooded areas are nevertheless affected.

A total of **500 families** or **2,000 persons** are affected in **Navotas City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **500 families** or **2,000 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱404,300.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
