





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Zamboanga City and Zamboanga Sibugay

as of 01 July 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

Several flooding incidents occurred in Barangay San Roque in Zamboanga City in Zamboanga del Sur Province and thirteen (13) barangays in Municipality of Siay, Zamboanga Sibugay was due to continuous rains brought about by the Low Pressure Area located 45KM Northeast of Dipolog City, Zamboanga del Norte imbedded with the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Southern Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao last June 26, 2024.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 3,167 families or 14,465 persons are affected in 14 barangays in Zamboanga City and Zamboanga Sibugay (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **2,816 families** or **14,080 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 11 houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and 10 are partially damaged in Zamboanga City and Zamboanga Sibugay (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P12,188.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
