





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Asingan, Pangasinan

as of 17 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On June 29, 2024, at around 3:30 PM, a tornado struck two (2) separate barangays—Brgy. Toboy and Brgy. Sobol—in Asingan, Pangasinan, resulting in the devastation of three (3) houses. Among these, two (2) houses were completely destroyed, while one (1) sustained partial damage. This incident affected three (3) families comprising 12 individuals. The affected families are currently undertaking temporary repairs on their homes and have chosen to remain in their residential area.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Asingan, Pangasinan, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of three (3) families or twelve (12) persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Asingan, Pangasinan (see Annex A).

# III. Damaged Houses

A total of three (3) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Asingan, Pangasinan (see Annex B).

## IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}52,016.52\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of \$\mathbb{P}25,216.52\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}26,800.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
