

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur

as of 28 June 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 June 2024 at around 1:30 PM, a tornado was experienced in Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur.

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are affected in **Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

Inside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **six (6) persons** are currently taking temporary shelter at the **Macatcatud Evacuation Center** in **Magsingal, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex B).

One (1) house was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Macatcatud, Magsingal, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex C).
