

# DSWD DROMIC Report #132 on the Effects of El Niño as of 12 July 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

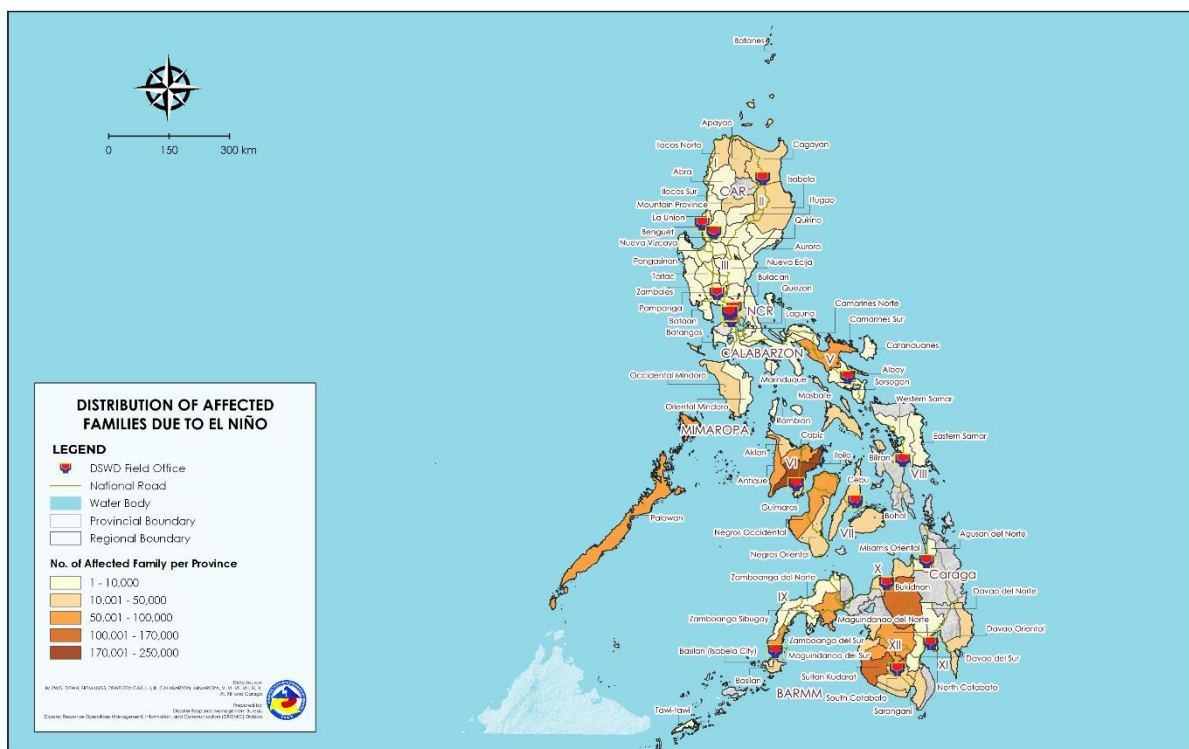
On 04 June 2024, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) reported that El Niño in the tropical Pacific Ocean has ended, as both oceanic and atmospheric indicators have returned to El Niño Southern Oscillation (ENSO)-neutral levels. Moreover, a transition from ENSO-neutral to La Niña conditions remains likely (about 69% chance) by the July-August-September 2024 season.

From July 2023 to May 2024, El Niño conditions were observed in the tropical Pacific Ocean. The effects of El Niño were felt in the Philippines that lead to agricultural damages and water shortages reported in various Regions.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,625,186 families** or **6,265,031 persons** are affected in **8,100 barangays** in **Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, CAR, and BARMM** (see Annex A).



### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱926,956,124.60** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱866,141,864.60** from the **DSWD**, **₱50,504,010.00** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱1,799,000.00** from the **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)** and **₱8,511,250.00** from **Other Partners** (see Annex B).
