

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorm in Lambunao, Iloilo

as of 19 July 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2024 at around 4:00 PM, heavy rains were experienced in Lambunao, Iloilo which caused flooding in low-lying areas, particularly in Brgy. Tranghaiwan. The flood reached households and lasted for about 2 to 3 hours before it eventually subsided. There was also a reported landslide incident in Brgy. Pughanan around 7:00 PM which caused partial damage to one (1) residential house.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **185 families** or **705 persons** are affected in **eight (8) barangays** in **Lambunao, Iloilo** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Outside Evacuation Center

**Three (3) families** or **10 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Pughanan, Lambunao, Iloilo** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱80,414.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱21,762.00** from **DSWD** and **₱58,652.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
