

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2-A, Davao City as of 16 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 July 2024 at around 8:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Magallanes St., Brgy. 2-A, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 1:05 AM on 14 July 2024.

A total of **152 families** or **539 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2-A, Davao City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **152 families** or **539 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Magallanes Elementary School** in **Brgy. 2-A, Davao City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **66 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 2-A, Davao City** (see Annex C).
