## I. Situation Overview

On 27 June 2024 at around 6:12 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 7:00 AM.

A total of **10 families** or **27 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **10 families** or **27 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 10 houses were damaged; of which, seven (7) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱94,560.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱84,560.00 from DSWD and ₱10,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
