

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte as of 07 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 June 2024 at around 6:12 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 7:00 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **10 families** or **27 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **10 families** or **27 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Hall** in **Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **10 houses** were damaged; of which, **seven (7)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Acmac, Iligan City, Lanao Del Norte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱94,560.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱84,560.00** from **DSWD** and **₱10,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
