

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City as of 28 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 July 2024 at around 4:40 PM, a fire incident occurred at Calle Punta, Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **281 families** or **858 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **281 families** or **858 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at a **Covered Court** in **Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **133 houses** were **damaged**; of which **129** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Camino Nuevo, Zamboanga City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱692,732.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
