

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu as of 20 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 18 July 2024 at around 2:08 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 2:54 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **99 families** or **397 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **99 families** or **397 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Mayor A.S. Fortuna Memorial Elementary School** in **Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **95 houses** were damaged; of which, **83** are **totally damaged** and **12** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Guizo, Mandaue City, Cebu** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱160,850.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
