## **DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City**

as of 03 July 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 30 June 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:07 PM.

### **II. Status of Affected Areas and Population**

A total of **43 families** or **113 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

### **III. Status of Displaced Population**

#### **a. Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **five (5) families** or **19 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **(1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

#### **b. Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **38 families** or **94 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

#### **c. Total Displaced Population**

There are **43 families** or **113 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex E).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

A total of **19 houses** were damaged; of which, **15** are **totally damaged** and **four (4)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex F).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱363,804.82** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱282,557.92** from **DSWD** and **₱81,246.90** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex G).
