I. Situation Overview

On 22 June 2024 at around 10:00 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 1, Santa Cruz, Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City. The fire was declared out at around 10:30 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

One (1) family or eight (8) persons are affected in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There is **one** (1) family or **eight** (8) **persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was totally damaged in Brgy. Rogongon, Iligan City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}11,698.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, \$\mathbb{P}5,698.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}6,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
