





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte

as of 07 August 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 July 2024 at around 6:15 PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok Coca-Cola, Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 6:35 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of six (6) families or 33 persons are affected in Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of six (6) families or 33 persons sought temporary shelter at the Brgy. Tubod Hall in Iligan City, Lanao del Norte (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **two (2)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tubod, Iligan City, Lanao del Norte** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}56,736.00\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}50,736.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}6,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
