

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Cavite City as of 16 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 July 2024 at around 3:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 5 and Brgy. 7 in Cavite City. The fire reached the 4<sup>th</sup> alarm affecting the neighboring houses.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **933 families** or **3,732 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Cavite City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **753 families** or **2,672 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Cavite City** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **180 families** or **1,060 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **933 families** or **3,732 persons** displaced in **Cavite City** (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱5,525,315.25** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
