

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Shooting Incidents in Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 07 August 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 July 2024 at around 9:00 PM, a shooting incident perpetrated by an unidentified group transpired in Brgy. Mompong, Datu Odin, Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte. On the following day, other shooting incidents connected to the same group were reported in barangays Linek, Badak and Kusiong in the same municipality.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,438 families** or **8,628 persons** are affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,007 families** or **6,042 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **431 families** or **2,586 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

There are **1,438 families** or **8,628 persons** displaced in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱500,479.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex E).
