

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 2-A, Davao City as of 19 July 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 July 2024 at around 8:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at Magallanes St., Brgy. 2-A, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 1:05 AM.

Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XI, promptly provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

A total of **152 families** or **539 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 2-A, Davao City** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **152 families** or **539 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Magallanes Elementary School** in **Brgy. 2-A, Davao City** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **66 houses** are **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 2-A, Davao City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱458,430.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
