





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City

as of 05 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 June 2024 at around 4:16 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:07 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **43 families** or **113 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Maria Cristina**, **Jaro**, **Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **five (5) families** or **19 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Iloilo Baptist Church** in **Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **38 families** or **94 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 43 families or 113 persons displaced in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 19 houses were damaged; of which, 15 are totally damaged and four (4) are partially damaged in Brgy. Maria Cristina, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}605,804.82\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}524,557.92\$ from \$DSWD\$ and \$\mathbb{P}81,246.90\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
