

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental as of 07 July 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2024 at around 10:17 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 10:50 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **17 families** or **58 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **17 families** or **58 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Gracia Elementary School** in **Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **17 houses** were damaged; of which, **14** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Sugbongcogon, Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱216,020.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱156,020.50** from **DSWD** and **₱60,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
