



DSWD DROMIC Report #9 on the Effects of Easterlies in Central Visayas

as of 17 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 08 July 2024, the effects of Easterlies were reported in several municipalities in Region VII. Localized thunderstorms due to Easterlies brought intense rain showers accompanied by lightning and strong winds to the Cities of Mandaue and Lapu-Lapu, as well as the municipalities of Carmen, Catmon, Liloan, and Minglanilla in Cebu and Bindoy in Negros Oriental.

On the same day at 3:00 PM, a landslide incident occurred in Brgy. Linao, Minglanilla, Cebu. At 4:47 PM, the municipality of Bindoy, Negros Oriental experienced heavy rainfall which triggered landslides and flooding and led to significant damage to local infrastructures, residential properties, and casualties. At around 5:00 PM, a flooding incident occurred in the barangays of Corazon and Catmondaan in Catmon, Cebu. Also, a vehicle carrying several passengers was swept away by the strong river current in the Municipality of Liloan, Cebu at around 5:45 PM. In addition, gusty winds struck a barangay in Liloan, Cebu. Further, heavy to intense rains also caused a flooding incident in several barangays in Mandaue City. All of which resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,968 families** or **6,126 persons** were affected in **nine (9) barangays** in **Region VII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

- a. Inside Evacuation Center
 - A total of **135 families** or **538 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4)** evacuation centers in Region VII (see Annex B).
- b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **11 persons** are temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population
 One (1) family or 11 persons are displaced in Region VII (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **128 houses** were damaged; of which, **13** are **totally damaged** and **115** are **partially damaged** in **Region VII** (see Annex E).





V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱1,835,717.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱1,404,447.00 from DSWD and ₱431,270.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).

11 July 2024	 DSWD FO VII provided financial assistance to beneficiaries in Cebu province through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS). DSWD FO VII through its Municipal Action Team (MAT) in Bindoy provided technical assistance to the LSWDO in the gathering and validation of data of the affected families in Brgy. Cabugan, Bindoy, Negros Oriental.
