

## **DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 8 (Poblacion), Isabela, Negros Occidental**

04 July 2024, 6AM

### **I. Situation Overview**

On 29 April 2024 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 8 (Poblacion), Isabela, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:15 PM.

**One (1) family or five (5) persons** were affected in **Brgy. 8 (Poblacion), Isabela, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

**One (1) family or five (5) persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### **IV. Damaged Houses**

**One (1) house** was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 8 (Poblacion), Isabela, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

### **V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱4,978.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱3,978.00** from **DSWD** and **₱1,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
