

DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Callaguip, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur

29 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 July 2024 at around 3:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Callaguip, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur. The fire was declared out at around 4:15 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region I, together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Caoayan, Ilocos Sur, provided relief and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

Moreover, the LGU of Caoayan, Ilocos Sur, assumes the management of Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) and commits to continuously provide interventions as necessary hence, the termination of this report.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **five (5) families** or **19 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Callaguip, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **four (4) families** or **15 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **Brgy. Callaguip Evacuation Center** in **Caoayan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **five (5) families** or **19 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Callaguip, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** was **totally damaged** and **one (1)** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Callaguip, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱113,713.20** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of **₱98,013.20** from **DSWD** and **₱15,700.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
