I. Situation Overview

On 24 May 2024 at around 8:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 3, Bankers Village, Brgy. Dungon B, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 9:30 AM.

A total of **₱16,101.76** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
