



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Daug, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental

11 July 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 June 2024, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers due to easterlies or localized thunderstorms that may have brought possible flash floods or landslides in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 6:30 PM, a flash flood incident occurred in Brgy. Daug, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental that caused damages on vegetations and local roads. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI and PAGASA Daily Weather Bulletin
